ASSET TRACKING LOGISTICS AND SUPPLY SYSTEM

SUSTAINING THE MARINES' OPERATING FORCES

Keeping Marine Corps ground equipment in peak operating condition demands accurate, timely, and relevant information. ATLASS II+ provides near real-time status of all supply, maintenance, and readiness functions. This includes organizational inventory, preventive and corrective maintenance, equipment record jackets, requisitioning, receipt control, modifications, and calibrations. ATLASS II+ is a Naval Tactical Command Support System (NTCSS) application, which provides integrated support for Operational Maneuver from the Sea (OMFTS).



KEY FEATURES

ATLASS II+ provides the U.S. Marine Corps with online logistics, inventory, and financial management tools. The development and implementation of ATLASS II+ bring the Marine Corps one step closer to integrating ground and aviation logistics.

Some key features include:

- Plans, schedules, reports, and tracks maintenance, supply, and related logistics support actions.
- Provides total Marine Expeditionary Force (MEF) asset visibility for unit and intermediate level organizations. Presents a common picture of critical logistics information across the MEF.
- Interfaces with Federal Logistics Data System and Marine Air Ground Task Forces (MAGTF) Data Library (MDL) for current reference data.
- Reports maintenance, readiness, and logistics information.
- Improves data quality up, down, and across the chain of command.
- Interfaces with external systems (near real-time) to satisfy maintenance and supply

requirements and provides updates to financial data.

- Supports deployable and non-deployable units and quickly responds to MAGTF restructuring.
- Fully capable of supporting an Intermediate Level Supply Support organization.
- Supports wireless Automated Identification Technology (AIT).
- Interfaces with the Warehouse



Management System (WMS) Storage Retrieval, Automated Tracking Integrated System (STRATIS).

- Redistribution of Secondary Repairable to Material Command (MATCOM).

PRIMARY COMPONENTS

ATLASS II+ provides Marine Corps maintenance and supply personnel with quick, convenient access to data, which enables them to inventory, maintain, and account for ground equipment.

Maintenance: Creates, lists, and updates work orders and tasks; requisitions parts; signs off on all scheduled and unscheduled maintenance and material requirements; and allows users to view history records of all maintenance performed.

Supply: Requisitions parts; reports parts availability; maintains repairable, organic, and consumable inventories; and provides near real-time status response on parts/supplies requisitioned.

Readiness: Accurately reflects all assets including reportable, non-reportable, and pacing items and identifies deadlines assets, excesses, shortages, and general remarks.

Reports: Allows users to request a number of predefined reports, including supply inventory reports, and provides ad hoc reporting capability.

System: Controls personnel permissions and access, administration of system tables, interface controls, and system

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utilities. Allows an administrator to review requests for reports and release them for printing.

Other features of ATLASS II+ include:

Automatic and on-demand data backup.

- Interconnectivity to support multi-location MAGTFs.
- Online trouble calls reporting.
- Online help, user's guide, and other reference materials.
